Buildings at Haneda Airport to be Renamed in March 2020 International Terminal to become Terminal 3



From March 2020, international flights at Haneda Airport will operate from parts of Terminal 2 as well as from the current International Terminal.

In line with this change, the current International Passenger Terminal and the International Flight Parking Lot will be renamed.

The names of the Keikyu Line and Tokyo Monorail Line railway stations will also be changed. (Please refer to the press release from the Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism for the details.)

To avoid confusion among users of Haneda Airport, the Haneda Airport Public Relations Committee, a joint government and private-sector group to which Japan Airport Terminal Co., Ltd. and Tokyo International Air Terminal Corporation belong, will conduct an awareness campaign on the renaming in due course.
