Search Access Routes to and From Haneda Airport International Terminal Announcing the Launch of the TIAT ROUTE MASTER Service

A simple tool for searching train and bus routes also supporting English, simplified and traditional Chinese and Korean for the convenience of Japanese and foreign customers alike.

On 30 April 2015, Tokyo International Air Terminal Corporation (Head office: Ota Ward, Tokyo; President & CEO: Masayuki Sakurai) will launch an access route search service, TIAT ROUTE MASTER, on its Haneda Airport International Passenger Terminal website to offer customers a more convenient, simpler means of searching train and bus routes to and from the terminal. TIAT ROUTE MASTER has been developed in collaboration with Jorudan Co., Ltd. (Head Office: Shinjuku Ward, Tokyo; President & CEO: Toshikazu Sato) based on its Norikae-Annai Visit service. Besides Japanese, the service also allows searches in English, simplified and traditional Chinese and Korean for the convenience of visitors to Japan

Users can, for example, search the route from the international terminal to their hotel and even if they are unsure of the nearest station, they can find the quickest route by selecting their hotel from a drop down list. Of course, they can also use it to search the most suitable route from their hotel to the terminal.

By June 2015, we will add more functions to this service such as a function for searching the optimal route with the least amount of stress for customers using wheelchairs and baby strollers. In addition to this, we also have plans to provide information on fixed-fare taxis and introduce a navigation function for movement within the terminal, with a view to gradually enhancing our services.

Features of TIAT ROUTE MASTER

- 1. Provided in multiple languages for foreign visitors to Japan. (English, simplified and traditional Chinese, Korean)
- 2. Suggests the most suitable train and bus routes to and from the International Terminal at Haneda Airport.
- 3. Users can enter and search for stations, hotels, tourist spots and other places they want to visit and also select destinations from a list of major stations, hotels and facilities.
- 4. Route searches take walking time into account, and the walking speed settings can be adjusted to allow users sufficient time when traveling through unfamiliar places.




