Commissioning of Transit Facilities at Haneda Airport Domestic Passenger Terminals


Japan Airport Terminal Co., Ltd. is pleased to announce that transit facilities under construction since November last year will be commissioned to coincide with the increase of international slots at Haneda Airport on March 30, 2014.

The new facilities provide special passages in the domestic passenger terminals for connecting passengers moving between the domestic and international terminals. Passengers can get to where they need to go via a smooth and stress-free route using ramp buses operated by airline companies.

We will continuously work toward improving the functions of Haneda Airport by implementing measures to both improve its capability to act as an international hub and better serve an increasing number of foreign visitors to Japan.

[Outline of new facilities]

- Terminal 1
 Addition of a special passage with escalators (Fig. 1) that connects the arrival concourse with the departure lobby
- 2. Terminal 2
 Addition of special passages with escalators and elevators that connect the arrival concourse with the bus lounge (Fig. 2) and the bus lounge with the departure lobby, and expansion of the south bus lounge (Fig. 3)
